

Grand jury indicts 46

A Trumbull County grand jury on Thursday, June 15, 2023, handed up 46 indictments.

Arraignments in the felony cases will be scheduled in Trumbull County Common Pleas courtrooms within the next two weeks. Indicted on felony charges were:
