

In court action from Tuesday's session on June 27, 2023, before Judge Andrew D. Logan of Trumbull County Common Pleas Court:

- Kirsten Kuhns, 33, of Salem, received an indefinite two- to three-year prison sentence after pleading guilty on May 16, 2023, to a felonious assault charge. The case involved an episode that left a behavioral health employee needing surgery for injuries from the December 2022 assault. A police report states Kuhns was upset about being admitted into the adult diagnosis unit of Generations Behavioral Health on Colonial Drive, Liberty. She is accused of sweeping the right leg of a 52-year-old employee and then stomping on his right knee, which broke his shin bone just below his knee.
- Jacob A. Kuzan, 37, of Youngstown, pleaded guilty to three felony drug possession charges connected to a Feb. 14, 2022, search of premises in Liberty Township. Kuzan will be sentenced after undergoing a background report conducted by probation officers. He pleaded guilty to third-degree aggravated possession of drugs, and possession of cocaine charges as well as a fifth-degree aggravated possession of drugs charge. The police search netted 50 grams of methamphetamine as well as two grams of other substances including cocaine and oxycodone, prosecutors said. Some \$860 in cash was also seized which was forfeited by the defendant.
