

## 22 indicted by Trumbull grand jury

WARREN – A Trumbull County grand jury on Wednesday, June 28, 2023, returned 22 indictments including two sealed cases.

Also, during the latest session, the grand jurors visited and inspected conditions at the Trumbull County jail. The forman in a written report said the jury found the facility secure and clean, observing some wear on the building, rust on the drop ceiling grids and air exchangers were dirty.

The following felony indictments were made, with arraignments set within two weeks in the courtrooms of one of four Trumbull County Common Pleas judges:

- Trevon Johnson, 30, Colonial Drive, Youngstown, possession of cocaine (f4) and tampering with evidence (f3);
- William D. Spithaler, 56, Davis Peck Road, Farmdale, grand theft (f4), three counts breaking and entering (f5) and two counts vandalism (f5);
- Raymel Adams, 20, Second Street SW, Warren, carrying concealed weapons (f4);
- Laymon B. Duncan, 41, Freeman Street, Warren, aggravated possession of drugs (f3) and aggravated possession of drugs (f5);
- Austin Applequist, 28, Housel Craft Road, Cortland, possession of fentanyl-related compound (f5) and aggravated possession of drugs (f3) – superseding indictment;
- Bret L. Brown, 38, Olive Street, Niles, aggravated possession of drugs (f3);
- Maurice Roebuck, 35, Roberts Avenue NW, Warren, tampering with evidence (f3), aggravated possession of drugs (f5) and possession of fentanyl-related compound (f5);
- Andre J. Atwater, 28, Hiram Avenue, Warren, three counts aggravated possession of drugs (f5);
- Shawn M. Bell, 32, Halleck Street, Youngstown, possession of hashish (f5);
- Jessica M. Isenberg, 36, South Raccoon Road, Canfield, aggravated possession of drugs (f3);
- Austin C. Chace, 30, Fairfield School Road, Leetonia, grand theft motor vehicle (f4), eight counts of theft (f5) and four counts criminal trespass (m4);
- William L. Drummond, 37, Judyth Street, Warren, breaking and entering (f5) and receiving stolen property (m1);
- Darrell M. Phillips, 56, Durst Colebrook Road, North Bloomfield, felonious assault (f2);
- Robin Roberts, 22, Newton Drive, Newton Falls, two counts aggravated possession of drugs (f5);
